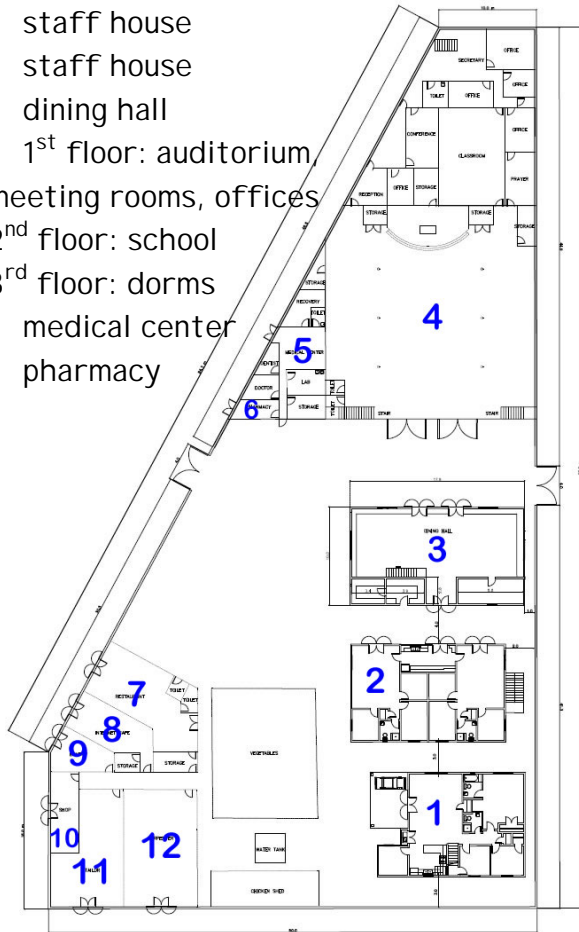

MALI

- In the 10/40 window in the heart of West Africa.
- Twice the size of Texas.
- Fifth-poorest nation in the world.
- Average annual income \$190.
- Two thirds (semi)desert.
- Two thirds farming.
- Two thirds of the 13 million people under the poverty line.
- Only Muslim nation with religious freedom.
- 90% Muslim, 9% pagan.
- Half the population under 15.
- Life expectancy 47 years.
- Women and children not valued.
- 1.5 out of 4 children never turn 5.
- Polygamy, female circumcision, forced child marriages.



PROPERTY in the capital of Bamako

- Ø Bamako with 2.2 million inhabitants
- Ø growing by 200,000 people a year
- Ø thousands of street children
- Ø child trafficking, forced labor, child sacrifices
- Ø concept of orphanage unknown



- Ø property in Yirimadio
- Ø on the edge of town
- Ø on the foot of a hill
- Ø new developing part of town
- Ø no electricity, no water, no telephone
- Ø property deeded to *Centre Apostolique Malien* by government



- v founded by Dr. Claudia R. Wintoch in Nov 2004
- v full gospel community center
- v church services
- v Bible School
- v daily street children's program
- v food & lodging for street children
- v literacy program for street children
- v feeding and clothing street children, widows, and the poor
- v orphanage with former street children
- v children's sponsorships
- v outreach into villages with no Christian witness
- v church planting in rural areas
- v partnerships with local pastors in village settings
- v outreaches with healing prayer and medical care
